An acupuncture session can range from 30minutes - 1 hour. First time patients will have up to 1.5hrs to make time for detailed exam, consultation and treatment.

We do take HSA/FSA funds. Call your insurance to find out your annual budget.

\*Please note that herbal medicine is not covered by health insurance and must be paid out of pocket.

**No Insurance Option:**

For those who do not have health insurance or denied coverage, we have a special discounted self-pay rate of **\$132 first visits and \$100 for follow up visits**. Price includes medical exam & consultation and acupuncture. Supplemental procedures such as acupressure, cupping, moxibustion, or gua sha that may be added for an additional cost based on individual diagnosis as listed above.

**No Show & Cancellation Policy:**

Cancellations require more than 24 hours notice. There is a fee of \$50 for late cancellations. Cancellations can be done via the online portal or call/text Citylife Acupuncture.

No show is defined as any patient who is more than 15 minutes late to their appointed time or not show for appointment at all. Patients will not be seen who are considered a no show until their next appointment. We charge a fee because the time agreed upon leaves a hole in the physician's day that could have been filled by another patient.
